

Our personal experiences with Woody Pet

1. USE AS BEDDING FOR HORSES

Woody Pet:

- The product does not break down and turn into dust, but maintains a consistency.
- I can start a stall with 4 or 5 bags and not need to use another bag for a month.
- Woody Pet absorbs urine smells readily and consistently.



The other pelleted bedding:

- The product quickly breaks down into a fine dust powder that can cause respiratory problems and skin irritation, possibly even cause laminitis.
- Because of the quick breakdown of the product more product must be
- used to absorb odors and maintain enough product for urine absorption.

2. USE IN COMPOSTING

Woody Pet:

- Used Woody Pet spread on property will grow grass within 2 to 3 months.

The other pelleted bedding:

- 'The other pelleted product' spread on property does not grow grass that I have observed (barren patches for almost a year).

3. USE AS BEDDING FOR SMALL ANIMALS, i.e. GUINEA PIGS

Woody Pet:

- Woody Pet maintains its urine absorption capabilities for at least a week.
- Very little, to no dust is generated.
- Woody Pet maintains a minimal to good odor for at least a week.
- Guinea pigs stay healthy.

The other pelleted bedding:

- Because of the rapid breakdown in the product its urine odor absorption is less.
- Dust generation causes water bottles to be caked and clogged with dust.
- Guinea pigs lost belly hair within 4 to 7 days from toxicity which I would have to attribute to phenols.

4. USE AS AN “OIL SPILL” CLEANUP

Woody Pet:

- Does not leave a dusty spot after absorbing oil spills.

The other pelleted bedding:

- Leaves a dusty residue after absorbing oil spills.

Woody Pet has significantly less dust than any other pelleted bedding we have used, no toxicity, higher urine and odor absorption. Woody Pet will perform longer and better than any other pelleted product.
